

2017 Snowsports Chaperone Signup Form

The school invites parents to chaperone at any one of the three sites to which we will be sending students. Adult chaperones must be related to a student participating in the program. They must be parents, guardians, grandparents, aunts, uncles, or adult siblings over the age of 21. Individuals wanting to be a chaperone must read this form, fill it out, sign it, and return it to the school before they go on any of the trips.

Chaperones are expected to work together to ensure that:

- all of the students are properly equipped and ready for their lessons.
- each instructional group has at least one adult accompanying the students in that group; chaperones are expected to remain with their instructional group for the entire lesson time.
- students are supervised in the lodge areas.
- students act safely during the free time.
- any student injuries, regardless of how minor, are reported to a school representative.
- students get ready for departure promptly and get on the bus.
- they are models of safety, common sense, and mountain etiquette for the children.

Chaperones at Crawford Notch and Bretton Woods will be able to participate for free. At Cannon Mountain, there are usually enough free passes for all of the adults who are helping out. Occasionally, we run out. Chaperone passes are \$6.00.
