The undersigned, being at least 21 years of age, hereby represents that he/she is the guardian of \_\_\_\_\_ (Hereinafter referred to as "child").

For myself and for the child, the undersigned agrees and understand that skiing/snowboarding is a hazardous activity, which may result in injury to my child during his/her participation in the Cannon Mountain Snowsports School (hereinafter Program). Trail conditions vary constantly because of weather changes and skier/snowboarder use. Natural and man-made obstacles, including other skiers/snowboarders may exist. Participants in Program are solely responsible for their speed and direction at any given time. Enrollment in Program shall not in any way eliminate the inherent risks in snow skiing/snowboarding. I hereby recognize that each person who participates in the sport of skiing/snowboarding accepts as a matter of law the dangers inherent in the sport and to that extent may not maintain an action against the operator for any injuries, which may result from such inherent risks, dangers, or hazards. The categories of such risks, hazards, or dangers which the participant assumes as a matter of law include but are not limited to the following: variation in terrain, surface or subsurface snow or ice conditions; bare spots; rocks, trees, stump and other forms of forest growth or debris; lift towers and components thereof (all of the foregoing whether above or below the snow surface); pole lines and plainly marked or visible snowmaking equipment; collisions with other skiers/snowboarders or other persons or with any of the categories included in this paragraph.

The undersigned further authorizes anyone working at Cannon Mountain Program to call for such medical care for the child or to transport the child to the appropriate clinic or hospital, if, in the opinion of anyone working at Cannon Mountain Program, medical attention is needed for the child.

The undersigned agrees to pay all costs associated with such medical care and related transportation for the child and indemnify and hold Cannon Mountain, its representatives, agents, affiliates, directors, servants, and employees harmless from any costs incurred therein.

## HCMS Snowsports Program Participation Agreement

I give my child, (please print legibly) \_\_\_\_\_,  
permission to participate in the 2018 HCMS Snowsports Program.

**Only students who are passing all of their classes as of the end of school on December 22, 2017 are eligible to sign up for the program.**

I understand and agree to the following:

1. My child's grades will be reviewed each Tuesday during the duration of the program. If my child is failing any of his or her classes at that time, then he or she will be expected to be in classes on the following Friday. He or she will not be excused from classes to participate in the program.
2. I understand that it is my child's responsibility to get from teachers any schoolwork he or she will miss each Friday and to do that work in a timely fashion. Participation in the program does not exclude students from doing the coursework that is done on the days they miss classes.
3. My child's behavior record will be reviewed each Tuesday during the duration of the program. If my child has been referred to the office more than once during the preceding week of school or has been suspended in or out of school, then he or she will be expected to be in classes on the following Tuesday. He or she will not be excused from classes to participate in the program.
4. I understand that refunds are not available if my child is deemed ineligible to go for academic or behavioral reasons.
5. I understand that my child is expected to stay with his or her instructional

group and follow the instructor's directions while at the mountain.

6. I understand that my child will be under the supervision of a school representative and parent chaperones during each visit to the mountain and that my child will need to follow the directions of these adults.

7. I understand that my child will be provided transportation each week by bus. I understand that I can make alternative transportation arrangements for my child and that I will communicate those to the school prior to leaving for the site. No phone calls or notes will be accepted at the sites.

8. I understand that my child must be appropriately dressed for each visit to the mountain and that if my child is not appropriately dressed for the weather, then he or she may be asked to stay in the lodge.
