

# Roles, Responsibilities & Rules

## \*CHAPERONES\*

- \* Assist students with rental equipment , boot fitting, flow of traffic and organizing students in Base Lodge
- \* Insure that all students are prepared and on time at the meeting area for start of lessons
- \* Accompany the group throughout the entire lesson, providing any assistance (ie. taking cold students to the lodge, bathroom runs, maintaining discipline, etc )
- \* Assume responsibility for students upon completion of the daily lesson

## \*Conduct\*

- \* In the interest of public safety, clear access to and through the Lodge must be maintained at all times - participants and their equipment must not block traffic at any time!
- \* Please be aware of noise levels and respect others
- \* When not in use Ski/Snowboard equipment must be racked and personal belongings should be stored in a way that does not infringe on others ability to enjoy the lodge
- \* The success of your schools program depends on everyone's cooperation. Behavior which is unsafe and/or inappropriate to the program will not be tolerated and may result in suspension from the program without refund. While at Cannon Mountain please follow the Skiers and Snowboarders Responsibility Code.
